



## FENDER® NECK INSTALLATION GUIDE

### Read Me First!

Congratulations on your purchase of a genuine Fender part, and thank you.

This is a real Fender body/neck—built to Fender specifications and designed to work with other genuine Fender parts. Please note that using this body/neck with a part not made by Fender is not recommended and that Fender cannot guarantee compatibility.

Hardware is not included and must be purchased separately. Make sure to use genuine Fender hardware, available from authorized Fender dealers.

Please use proper care when handling parts. Before attempting to attach a neck to a body, make sure that both the body's neck pocket and the area of the back of the neck that will sit in the neck pocket are free of anything that will prevent the neck from seating properly in the neck pocket (some cleaning may be required for optimal fit). Test-fitting the neck into neck pocket is highly recommended to ensure that the neck can be properly seated without being forced (the neck should never be forced into the neck pocket). After complete neck/body assembly, pilot holes must be drilled for pickguard installation. Final truss rod and nut adjustments are also necessary.

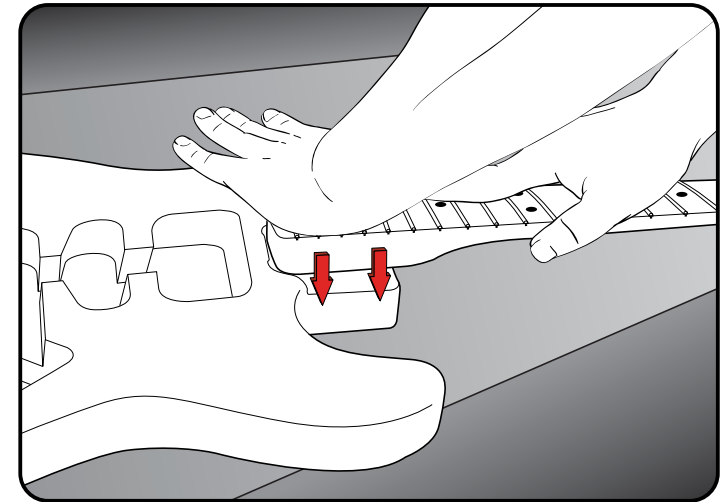

**GENUINE REPLACEMENT NECK AND BODY**  
**1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY**

Fender Musical Instruments Corporation ("FMIC") warrants this Fender replacement neck/body to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for one (1) year from the date of purchase to the original retail purchaser, subject to the limitations set forth herein. This warranty is applicable only when the replacement neck/body is purchased from an authorized Fender dealer and requires the purchaser to supply a copy of the original proof of purchase (original sales receipt with his/her name indicated as the purchaser, thereon) at the time service is requested.

Repair service of defects covered by this warranty can be performed only at an Authorized FMIC Service Center, as designated by FMIC. Remedies beyond normal service repair of any Fender replacement neck/body require both an evaluation of the defect and a direct recommendation from an Authorized FMIC Service Center for alternative considerations. A network of authorized service centers has been established for warranty service. Your Authorized Fender Dealer may also be authorized for warranty service and should be the first point of contact when service of any kind is required for your Fender replacement neck/body.

All transportation, insurance and freight charges associated with warranty service and repairs on Fender guitars are the responsibility of the purchaser, as is any service initiated for the purpose of customizing adjustments beyond factory specifications. All setup and adjustment after installation is the responsibility of the consumer.

This replacement neck/body should be installed only on the matching model counterpart. FMIC cannot guarantee the fit of the neck/body, if it is not installed on such matching model counterpart. Some modifications to neck/body may be necessary, to insure proper fit. Installation and modifications should be performed only by an experienced, qualified luthier. Improper installation or modification will void this warranty.

Limitations and Exclusions

The following items are not covered by this warranty:

1. Any damage to this replacement neck/body or the host neck/body caused by improper installation, servicing or modification.
2. Normal wear and tear on any part of this replacement neck/body including worn frets, string nut, and finish.
3. Setups, adjustments or routine maintenance of any kind.
4. Damage to finishes or cracks, splitting, or warpage of wood due to changes in temperature or humidity, exposure to or contact with sun, fire, moisture, body salts and acids of perspiration, guitar straps, guitar stands/hangers made from vinyl, plastic, rubber or other synthetic materials, any other chemicals or non-Fender® supplied polishes or cleaners.
5. Any replacement neck/body purchased from anyone other than an authorized Fender dealer.
6. All other damage and deterioration due to normal usage, wear and tear, customization, modification, aging, accidents, neglect, abuse or Acts of Nature.
7. This warranty is rendered void if the finish on the replacement neck/body has been removed.
8. Chipped, cracked and/or otherwise damaged string nut resulting from improper filing and/or improper handling.

This one-year warranty applies to this replacement neck/body only. *Note: Complete instruments constructed entirely of Fender replacement parts are not covered by the Limited Lifetime Warranty that accompanies an FMIC manufactured instrument.*

FMIC ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM FAILURE OF THIS PRODUCT NOR ANY LOSS OF INCOME, SATISFACTION, OR DAMAGES ARISING FROM THE LOSS OF USE OF SAME DUE TO DEFECTS OR AVAILABILITY OF SAME DURING SERVICE.

Any warranties implied by law (including warranties of merchantability or fitness) are limited to the duration of this express limited warranty. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you. Some states do not allow the exclusion of limitations of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

NOTE: This warranty applies only to products purchased and serviced within the U.S.A. and Canada. Warranties outside these countries are as defined by the authorized FMIC Distributor for your country or region, and may vary from the above in terms and/or length.
