

### **Chromatic Tuner Instructions**



#### **CONTROL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1) Flat LED Indicator
- 2) (In) TUNE LED Indicator
- 3) Sharp LED Indicator
- 4) On/Off

- 5) Input
- 6) Automatic Calibration
- 7) Mic
- 8) Note Indicator LED Display

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:**

- 1) For electric instruments, insert the cable into the "IN" jack. The internal mic will be automatically disconnected, so that the tuner will not pick up extraneous room noise.
- 2) For other instruments, which have no jack connection capability, position the tuner so that the instrument sound source is within 4-12 inches of the "Mic" holes on the top of the tuner. The internal microphone is very sensitive and will pick up even moderate volume notes.
- 3) Slide the ON/OFF switch to ON. You will see red and green LED lights flicker on.
- 4) Play a single note/tone that you want to tune and adjust the instrument's pitch (Up or Down) until the desired NOTE INDICATOR (red) (8) light is lit. For instance, if you want to tune an A string on a guitar, pluck the string and tune it until the "A" note indicator light is lit. You may have to pluck the string more every couple of seconds to keep the note at a consistent "vibrating" strength and prevent the note from fading flat.
- 5) While tuning, if the FLAT NOTE INDICATOR b (1) lights to the left of TUNE (2), the pitch of the note is flat. Adjust the instrument tuning and play the note again. If the SHARP NOTE INDICATOR # (3) lights to the right of TUNE (2), the pitch of the note is sharp. Adjust the instrument tuning and play the note again. Repeat until the TUNE (2) NOTE INDICATOR (green) lights. The note is then in tune. Special Note: SHARP AND FLAT NOTE INDICATORS blink rapidly when the note/tone is far from being in tune and blink slower and slower as the tone moves towards being IN TUNE. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the other notes until the entire instrument is tuned.
- 6) Automatic Calibration: The Fender Chromatic Tuner can be calibrated to match any instrument by simply pressing a button (6). For example: If the player wants to tune a guitar to match the pitch of a certain piano, play any note on the piano and wait a moment for the note to register on the tuner's display. Immediately touch the A. CALIB (6) button on the tuner. The green (In) TUNE light will go on, indicating that the tuner now considers the piano to be in perfect tune. Now if you tune your instrument (guitar, in this case) to the tuner, your instrument will be in tune with that piano. Returning the tuner to standard A = 440Hz reference is easy. Just move the power switch to OFF and then back ON. The tuner automatically resets its internal scale to A = 440Hz when it is turned on.
- 7) When finished using your tuner, make sure to turn off the tuner to conserve battery power.
