



Installation Instructions

1. Choose the desired location for guitar hanger to be mounted. If mounting to a concrete or brick surface, please **DO NOT** use the enclosed hardware. Appropriate masonry screws can be purchased at your local hardware store. For best results use a level and mount guitar hanger to a stud.
2. Use included foam pad as a template to mark the location of screw holes. Drill pilot holes where necessary, if a stud is not available, use included plastic drywall anchors.
3. Attach foam pad to back of mounting plate and drive the supplied screws through the mounting plate into stud or plastic drywall anchors using a Phillips screwdriver.
4. Place decorative cover over mounting plate.
(arrow on back of mounting plate indicates up)
5. Place standoff onto decorative cover, ensure logo on standoff is on the left side. Finally, thread guitar hanger through standoff and onto mounting plate by rotating in a clockwise direction.

DISCLAIMER: Fender® is not responsible for the method in which the purchaser attaches this hanger to the wall, the strength of the wall material it is placed on, or any damage to instruments from falling. We recommend that the finish on the neck of the instrument be fully cured before resting it in any hanger.

**DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN HANGER, IT SHOULD
SLIGHTLY ROTATE IN BOTH DIRECTIONS
WHEN INSTALLED CORRECTLY.**

This product has been tested with many finishes and no problems have been found. Nonetheless, please exercise caution when placing vintage instruments and instruments with nitrocellulose finishes on this stand. Sweat and other environmental contaminants, nitrocellulose and aging can produce chemical reactions between instrument finishes and stand components that can be neither predicted nor tested.
